We will accept donations until we can fill a container. The donations will be transported to Jacksonville where they will be shipped to Asociación de Maestros de Puerto Rico, the AFT teacher union office in San Juan. These supplies will be immediately distributed to families in the city and in other areas of the island.

Items To Be Sent To Puerto Rico

1. Food

- Canned meat
- Canned beans and vegetables
- Canned or dry soups (canned preferred due to water shortages)
- Canned fruit
- Peanut butter
- Rice
- Noodles
- Crackers
- **2. Hygiene** If possible, an individual hygiene kit, to include:
- 1 Toothbrush (individually wrapped)
- 1 Small toothpaste
- 1 Deodorant (unisex)
- 1 Body soap (liquid or bar)
- 1 Small shampoo
- 1 Small hand sanitizer
- 1 Disposable razor
- 1 Small Shaving cream
- 1 Small Lotion
- Adult disposable diapers
- Women's hygiene products

3. Baby supplies

- Formula
- Diapers
- Wipes
- Lotion

4. Other

- C and D Batteries
- Mosquito Repellant
